Sri M. Ramakanth, Advocate for petitioner and Sri D. N. Sarma, OSD (Legal and Commercial) for respondents are present. The counsel for petitioner stated that the matter before the Hon'ble High Court is still pending and efforts are being made for early disposal of the matter. Therefore, a long adjournment may be granted. The representative of the respondents stated that instead of giving a longer date, let the matter lie over till the disposal of the case pending before the Hon'ble High Court and upon filing a memo for hearing, the matter may be taken up for consideration. The Commission pointed out that the above suggestion was made earlier. At this stage, the counsel for petitioner has agreed to the suggestion for placing the matter as lie over and he will file a memo soon after the disposal of the matter before the Hon'ble High Court. In view of the above, the matter is adjourned without any date.
