Matrugupta Mishra, Advocate for the petitioner on 19.11.2020, 28.01.2021 and 18.02.2021, Sri Aman Sheikh, Advocate representing Sri. Matrugupta Mishra, Advocate for the petitioner on 17.12.2020 and 11.01.2021, Sri Mohammad Bande Ali, Law Attachee alongwith Sri K. Satish Kumar, DE TSSPDCL for respondents on 19.11.2020 and Sri Mohammad Bande Ali, Law Attachee for the respondents on 17.12.2020, 11.01.2021, 28.01.2021 and 18.02.2021 have appeared through virtual hearing. The petition having been heard

and having stood over for consideration to this day, the Commission passed the following:

ORDER

M/s. GMR Energy Trading Limited has filed a petition under section 86 (1) (b), (f) and (k) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with clauses 8 and 13 of power purchase order (PO) dated 01.12.2017, seeking the following prayer:

“to direct the respondent No. 1 to honour the invoice dated 08.08.2018 and make payment of Rs. 1,45,16,560/- to the petitioner towards late payment surcharge along with interest.”

3. The petition was taken for consideration and during penultimate date of hearing, the counsel for petitioner stated that they are making efforts to settle the matter out of court and accordingly, a letter had been sent to the respondents. The representative of the respondents confirmed the receipt of the said letter. Now when the matter is taken up for hearing on 18.02.2021, the counsel for petitioner represented that the matter has been settled and payment has been made towards the amount due from the respondents and accordingly requested closure of the matter, as no further orders are required in the matter. The representative of the respondents confirmed the same.

4. Considering the submissions of the parties, the petition stands closed.
