These applications having stood over for consideration to this day, the Commission passed the following:

COMMON ORDER

The distribution companies of Telangana (TSDISCOMs) (applicants) have filed Miscellaneous Petitions / Applications, from time to time, under clause 42 of the Conduct of Business Regulations, 2015 seeking extension of time for filing Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) and Tariff proposals for retail supply business for FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-21 and Multi-Year-Tariff (MYT) filing for distribution business for 4th control period i.e., from FY 2019-20 to FY 2023-24 by abridging the period of requirement of filing 120 days prior to issue of tariff order in clause 6.1 of Regulation No.4 of 2005 as adopted by TSERC vide Regulation No.1 of 2014, expressing the following unavoidable difficulties:

- i. Delay in receipt of information of upcoming Lift Irrigation (LI) schemes, analysing and finalizing the data of LIS, uncertainty in commissioning of Lift Irrigation pumps, etc.
- ii. Delay in receipt of information on power availability and costs thereon from Central Generating Stations.
- iii. Model Code of Conduct prevailing in the Telangana State, from time to time, due to various election schedules.
- iv. Revision of cost estimates due to finalisation of audited accounts for the Base year i.e., FY 2018-19.
- v. Preparation of Tariff proposals in accordance to the Ministry of Power recommendations on Tariff Rationalisation proposals.

2. The Commission had admitted the applications and the same were taken on record by assigning the numbers and stating that the application will be taken up along with the ARR filings. The details are as given below:

Subsequently, the applicants have filed MYT proposals for distribution business for 4th control period on 16.12.2019, the same were admitted, taken on record, assigned O.P.Nos.9 and 10 of 2019, considered and disposed of by order dated 29.04.2020. The applicants further filed ARRs for FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-21 along with ARR for FY 2021-22 for retail supply business on 31.03.2021 without accompanying the Filings for Proposed Tariff (FPT) and the same were not

entertained at admission stage by the Commission by order dated 22.12.2021 in O.P.(SR) Nos.14 and 15 of 2021 mainly for the reason that the time period for which they were sought was already lapsed.

4. In view of the above factual situation, these applications do not survive in the circumstances of disposal of the petitions concerning ARR for retail supply business for FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-21 and MYT filings for distribution business for 4th control period. Accordingly, the same are closed. Any other Miscellaneous Petition concerning extension of time for filings of ARR are also closed.
