TELANGANA STATE ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

REGULATION No. 6 OF 2022

Preamble:

The Commission had notified the Regulation No.3 of 2021 being the Telangana State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Deviation Settlement Mechanism and related matters) Regulation, 2021 (hereinafter referred to as 'Principal Regulation') in the Telangana Gazette on 16.06.2021, which shall come into force from the effective date i.e., on 1st April 2022. TSSLDLDC had requested this Commission to reschedule the effective date of implementation of the Principal Regulation until the outcome of Draft CERC (Deviation Settlement Mechanism and Related Matters) Regulations, 2021 is known, i.e., when the final notification of Regulations is made by CERC.

The Commission after careful examination of the request made by the TSSLDLDC considers it appropriate to reschedule the effective date of implementation of the Principal Regulation.

Accordingly, in exercise of powers conferred on it under sub-section (3) of Section 32, sub-section (4) of Section 33, clauses (b) and (h) of sub-section (1) of Section 86 read with clause (g) and (z) of sub-section (2) of Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act No.36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, and after previous publication, the Telangana State Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following Regulation to amend the Principal Regulation, namely: -

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1 Short title, Extent and Commencement

- (i) This Regulation shall be called the Telangana State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Deviation Settlement Mechanism and related matters) First Amendment Regulation, 2022.
- (ii) This Regulation shall extend to the entire State of Telangana.
- (iii) The Regulation shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Telangana Gazette.

2 For clause 1.(3) of the Principal Regulation the following clause shall be substituted

“This regulation shall come into force from the effective date i.e., on 1st October 2022:

Provided that SLDC will arrange for and complete all necessary modifications or development of the software and all other aspects connected or incidental thereto including trial run of accounting of State Deviation Pool Account for smooth implementation of the regulation from the effective date:

Provided further that till the date prior to the effective date of this regulation the provisions of Open Access Regulation shall remain in force for the purpose of energy accounting and deviation settlement:
